B

Most public high school teachers in the United States never expected a school year like this

year's. Education went online and has continued.

Teachers quickly found they would not be able to teach as much material as usual to their students. The educators had to make choices about what to teach and what could be dropped. So, English teachers began cutting some books and writing projects from their teaching plans. History teachers began to reduce their teaching on some periods in history. Science teachers had to remove experiment-based work because school laboratories were no longer available.

Reeves is a Spanish teacher. By this time in a school year, she usually knows her students well. But this year is different. She said learning online is especially difficult for students in language classes. At the start of a school year, she explained, some students can be shy about saying a word incorrectly in front of their friends. But after a while, they understand everyone in the class. At that point, they are not shy any more. But at home, Reeves said, the students are shyer. They worry about making mistakes in front of their parents.

▲ Jake said some of his students are doing better than in the past. Because of the coronavirus health crisis, they don't have many other things to do. "They are studying material hard and gaining a higher level of skill very, very quickly." Alison is hopeful about the future for her students, even with less teaching time and fewer subjects. She said, "Students are learning how to deal with difficult educational conditions. That will truly take them much further than a lot of learning material." Tassie expressed the similar idea, "We have students at my school that are working and helping support their families and taking care of their family members, and still going to class every day and doing their work. That's quite good and encouraging."

SHANGHAI—After finishing dinner, Liu Xu started a WeChat mini-program called "Clear Plate" on his phone and took a picture of the empty plates. He was then awarded 157 points after the photo was recognized by artificial intelligence (人工智能). "Users of the app can use their points to buy gifts or order charity meals for children in poor areas," Liu said.

The Shanghai citizen used the mini-program to record himself "clearing the plate." Liu also joined a group of like-minded people who are in a

campaign (活动) called “Clear Your Plate”. The purpose of this campaign is to stop food waste and encourage customers to save food in restaurants. Also, restaurants are encouraged to offer different portion (份) sizes so that customers can have more choices. Up to now, the “Clear Plate” mini-program has become popular among young Chinese and has nearly 1 million users. Similar campaigns like an “Empty Plate Challenge” are also found in many Chinese universities.

“Technological innovation (创新) is a good way to reduce food waste,” said Liu Jichen, founder of the company that developed the app. The idea was shown at a dinner in 2017, when Liu found that a restaurant would give diners who ate up their food a card and offer small gifts after they collected enough cards. “Everyone who doesn’t waste food could enjoy a sense of gain at a lower cost.” Liu said. Such an idea could be realized online, so Liu led his team to work on the project. Now, Liu and his team are working hard to make the AI system smarter.

Through the mini-program, people can clearly see the good results of saving food, which will effectively reduce waste.

“We hope our efforts can start a new way among the young, encouraging them to develop the habit of loving and saving food,” Liu said.

Good news for fans of Chinese animations(动画)! The year 2021 will bring plenty of choices. According to news website TMT, 188 Chinese animated(动画的) series will come out this year on Tencent Video, iQiyi. Among them are new seasons of older shows, including the fourth season of *Douluo Dalu*.

Nearly 50% of the new works are in guofeng style, or traditional Chinese style. The stories are mainly adapted(改编) from traditional Chinese tales or literature. For example, *The Westward* comes from *Journey to the West*.

"As people in our society get wealthier, it's natural that Chinese people have greater pride and confidence in their own culture," Mou Aili, a professor from Chongqing, told China Daily. This is why these guofeng animations are rising in China.

Original(原创的) works are also increasing in 2021. For example, *Time Agents* is an original series from Haoliners Animation League and other companies. It is the story of two young men who run a photo studio. They have the ability to enter their customers' photos and change their past. Another work, *Li's Little Kitchen* shows that delicious food can make people feel warm.

With more companies providing money and supporting the development of more excellent Chinese original animated works, almost everyone believes Chinese animated industry will be better.

B

Some parents in Qingdao complained because the school chose a PE teacher as the head teacher (班主任).

The local education bureau (教育局) quickly replied. On Friday, at a news conference in Beijing, the spokesman said that teachers in legal (合法的) schools own teaching ability. Teachers teach different subjects and this makes them different. They also expressed the hope that the try of a PE teacher as a head teacher would be understood and accepted by more parents.

That is the correct opinion. All teachers must pass exams and interviews before getting a teaching job. Different teachers are good at different subjects. Head teachers not only teach their own subjects, but also lead other teachers to work as a team and keep classes running smoothly.

The school clearly feels that the experienced PE teacher has the necessary ability of being a head teacher.

At the news conference, the spokesman also said that more attention will be paid to PE lessons, and the subject will be given as much importance as Chinese language or math. In the examinations for high schools, the points for PE lessons will rise to be the same as the so-called main subjects like Chinese language, math, and English.

It is a good move to pay more attention to PE as it is important for children's health. However, if the policymakers (决策者) increase its points to the same as Chinese language and math, they should do so step by step in order to make parents accept it.

The high school entrance examination will make these students with more potential (潜力) for higher education in the future. Thus, PE is not only important, but also basic to future health. And its importance can also be shown by increasing more PE classes in school.
